<b>For which purposes does the health system process my data?</b>	In order to ensure protection from the health emergency caused by the spread of Coronavirus.
<b>Why is processing data legitimate?</b>	For reasons of public interest in the public health field, in particular to protect from serious cross-border threats to health (art.9, paragraph 2, letter i) of EU Reg. 2016/679)
<b>Who will my data be shared with?</b>	Your data could be: <u>communicated</u> to other health facilities, public or private, or to other public or private subjects; In particular: The information regarding the state of health of patients with COVID-19 pathology is accessible by regulatory obligation, and for the purpose of the full performance of institutional activities, to the Prefect, to the Mayor of residence or domicile, to Civil Protection, to Social Assistance Services and municipal health for specific cases, to volunteers engaged in support activities and those subjects who had some type of direct interaction with the patient.

<b>How long will my data be kept?</b>	For the time needed to reach the purposes they were processed for, excluding the greater time necessary to fulfill legal obligations due to the nature of the data or document, for reasons of public interest or for the scope of public powers.
<b>How will they process my data?</b>	The data will be processed exclusively to allow healthcare staff to have a complete picture of your current medical history and to evaluate the best treatment, in the utmost caution and therapeutic safety, in the prevention of contagion from COVID-19 <b><u>to protect your own health, the one of other patients and the one of the medical staff.</u></b> Appropriate security and data protection measures are adopted and in compliance with the provisions of current legislation and the related principles, in particular with the provisions of article 5 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679, to protect the rights and freedom of the involved persons.
<b>Who will process my data?</b>	Your personal data, including health data, will be processed by duly authorized and trained medical personnel, as well as by subjects as managers chosen by the Company.

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<b>Which are my rights?</b>	Regarding your personal data, provided by you in the context of an epidemiological emergency by COVID-19, you have the right to obtain • access • rectification • cancellation • limitation of processing of data • opposition to the processing of data. For further information, see articles 15-22 of EU Reg. 679/2016. You can exercise your rights by writing to the email address of the Data Controller or Data Protection Officer.
<b>Who can I complain to?</b>	If you think that your rights have been violated, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Guarantor Authority for the protection of personal data through the method indicated on the website <a href="http://www.garanteprivacy.it">www.garanteprivacy.it</a> .
